Outstanding DECA Chapter Advisor Award

Sponsored by DECA, Inc., Virginia DECA will recognize all DECA chapter advisors who are actively involved in DECA and related teaching activities. Attached is a list of Virginia approved activities with point values attached to each. To earn the Outstanding DECA Chapter Advisor Award, **an advisor must earn a total of 100 points**. During the 2005-2006 school year points will begin in August and accumulate through the Virginia DECA State Leadership Conference (SLC). For the 2006-2007 school year, points will begin to accumulate at the 2006 SLC and end at a time designated prior to next year's SLC (similar to our Annual Report). Advisors who accumulate the required number of points will submit a brief application (below) to Virginia DECA documenting each activity. Qualifying chapter advisors will earn a lapel pin and certificate from DECA, Inc. recognizing their achievement.

This year will be awkward, as you may be required to include some of last year's information (such as SLC attendance). It will run full-cycle for next year. For this year, if in question, count it! For example, you will need to use last year's SLC participation.
